


The Voice of Healing Magazine (Issues from 1948 to 1966)



The Healing Revival of the mid 1940's to late 1960's was an incredibly far reaching movement. Wonderful amounts of independent evangelists and ministers filled huge auditoriums and massive tents. He published "The Voice of Healing" magazine featuring revival and their ministry efforts.
