JANUARIA LILLIA



Janwaria Lillian has 8 years. She lives in Lutungu Village where the school is located. Her both parents died of AIDS in 2005 and currently she stays with her aunt. The parents died when they had 3 children, one of these children died in 2008 the other child stays with the grandparents. Lillian was tested blood and the results indicated that she is HIV Positive currently she takes seprine every day which dear aunt gets from Butiti dispensary. Lillian is now in Top class she is determined to study and capable of performing better though she often fall sick. We visited her one time and found out that she sleeps on Pyprus mats and covers her self with rugged clothes. She doesn't sleep under mosquito net that is why she often suffers from malaria fever. Her aunt is very poor she is unable to help this child to live a better life.

**SHAKURU WANGI**



Shakuru wangi is 5 year old. He lives in Lungu village where the school is located . His both parents died of AIDS in 2007. These parents left 5 children, the elder child is 18 years and currently he is the head of the family.

Shakuru comes from a child headed family. Shakuru is lucky because he is not infected with AIDS, only one child in their family is infected with IAD.

These 5 children lives a miserable life because their elder brother is not able to meet all their needs. He left school in 2008 due to lack of school fees. There was also a need for him to work hard so as to meet the need of his young brothers and sisters.

Shakuru Wangi is among the children who do not pay the little school fees, children are supposed to pay at school and he is under the elder brother.

## **NAKATE KIZZA.**



Nakate Kizza is 8 years old. She is in Top class she lives in Tata Village which is 5 Kilometers from where the school is located. Her father died of AIDS in 2010 currently , Nakate Kizza stays with her mother who is also infected with AIDS. Her father sold almost every thing they had after realizing that he was infected with AIDS . Nakate has three brothers and one sister. They all stay with their mother. They live a desperate life because their father sold every thing he had including the house where they were staying, they now live in a hired room. Their mother works in the gardens of other people who give her money that she uses to buy food for her Children. Nakate Kizza often falls sick from malaria due to lack of mosquito net and the bad situation at home especially poor feeding and sleeping in ragged and dirty clothes.

## **Birungi maria**



Birungi maria is 11 years. She lives in Kiwenda village which is 4 kilometers from where the school is located. Her mother got married to a man who was living in Kyotera town then after some time they separated when Birungi maria was just 9 months old. Unfortunately the husband was infected with AIDS, Currently the mother to Birungi Maria is also infected with AIDS. She was tested blood and found out that she is HIV Positive. She takes ARVS every day, bad enough Birungi Maria is also infected with AIDS. She was tested blood and found out that she is HIV Positive. She takes Seprine every day and she is growing very weak. Birungi Maria stays with her mother and grand parents.

She likes studies and is capable of getting good results at the end of primary seven.

**Lutaaya Alex,**



Lutaya Alex is 11 years old, he is in primary one. He lives in Lutungu Village in which the school is located. His parents separated in 2006. He stays with the grand parents who are very old and unable to meet his needs. The child monitoring team, one time visited him and reported to us that he sleeps on the floor with a small dirty and old papius mat laid on it. He has an old blanket full of holes which he uses to cover him self during night. His attendance is irregular because of times he goes to the garden to dig so that him self and his grand parents may get what to eat. He has been sick for the whole of last week. He was suffering from malaria due to lack of mosquito net

## **KISSEKA RONALD.**



Ki-sse-ka Ronald is 7 years old, He is in Top class. Ronald lives in Lutugu village just a hundred metres from where the school is located. His both parents died in 2008 leaving behind 5 children. They are all staying with their grandmother.

Their grandfather passed away last year in November. His father died after selling almost every thing he had because he was desperate and did not plan for the children he left behind .

According to the report given by child – monitoring team these children sleep on papyrus mats, they cover them selves with ragged clothes, Kisseka did not get a mosquito net because we gave a net to her sister Nagawa Bridget, we did not have enough nets for all children, so we had to give a net to one child from each family. Kisseka Ronald is HIV negative and likes studies.

**KAYANJA FRANCIS.**



Ka-ya-nja Francis is 7 years old, He is in Top Class. He lives in Kiwenda village which is 4 kilometres from where the school is located.

Kayanja has both parents, but his pa care of his children most of the time, he is in the bar taking alcohol. His mother works had to ensure that she gets money to provide needs to her children. One day I visited their family, but I was very surprised by the report the mother gave me that at times they can for go meals for the whole day. The father treats them harshly and sells part of his land whenever he runs short of money to take to the bar. The mother showed me where the children sleep, I was surprised to find that they sleep on fiber mats and cover them selves with an old back cloth.

## **NAMULI RITAH.**



Na-mu-li Ritah is 8 years old. She is in primary one. She lives in Lutungu village 2 kilo metres from where the school is located.

Namuli Ritah stays with her grand parents, Her parents died in 2009 leaving behind 6 children.

They all stay with their grand parents, unfortunately Ritah is infected with AIDS, her grand parents are advanced in years, and unable to give proper care to these children especially Ritah who needs enough care. Ritah takes septine every day which her elder brother gets from Butiti dispensary. Their grand parents have a big land but they are unable to tilt it and get food for their grand children.

This situation force the children to do garden work in order to get what to eat. They sleep on papyrus mats and cover themselves with back cloth. Her sister Lillian got a mosquito net.



## **NAKABANDA WINNIE**



Na-ka-ba-nda Winnie is 9 years old, she is in primary two. She lives in Lutungu Village 3 kilometer from where the school is located, Her parents died in 2007 leaving behind 6 children.

Nakabanda Winnie currently stays with Her Aunt, she was tested blood and the results indicated that she is HIV positive, she takes Septrine every day which her Aunt gets from Butiti dispensary, unfortunately Nakabanda's Aunt is also infected with AIDS, her husband died last year in June. He died after selling almost every thing he had. Nakabanda and her Aunt live a very hard life. Her Aunt works in other peoples' gardens in order to get the money that she uses to buy food and other needs at home. Nakabanda sleeps on the floor where she lays ragged clothes and cover herself with an old blanket full of holes. Nakabanda Winnie got a mosquito net, We hope this will protect her from malaria fever.

## **NAKASULE IMMACULATE.**



Na-ka-sule Immaculate is 4 years old. She is in baby class, she lives in Lutungu village just one kilometer from where the school is located. Immaculate stays with her grand parents. Her mother got married to a man who died of IDS after 2 years of their marriage. Her mother last year got married to another man. This forced the grand parents of immaculate to bring her to their home and stay with her. Immaculate is HIV negative but the grand parents do not take enough care of her.

She sleeps together with Namakula Flavia who got a mosquito net.

They sleep on fiber mats and covers them selves with an old blanket full of holes. Immaculate likes studies and her attendance at school is regular.

## NAMAGANDA LAILAH



Na-ma-ga-nda Lailah is 9 years old. She is in primary one. Namaganda lailah lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometers from where the school is located. Lailah has both parents but her father is a drunkard .He spends much of his time in bars drinking alcohol. The father to Lailah treats them harshly, their home is full of domestic violence. This situation often forces the mother to leave home and stay with her parents almost for a full year .The father to Lailah have never bought even a single cloth to his children, their mother is responsible to meet all their needs but again these children suffer a lot when their mother is not at home . Lailah and her two sisters sleep on papyrus mats and cover themselves with the blanket which the school gave them. They also sleep under mosquito net which Lailah got from school.

## NAKIGONA ANGEL.



Na-ki-go-na Angel is 10 years old. She is in primary one. She lives in Lutungu village 300 meters from where the school is located. Nakigona Angel stays with her two brothers and three sisters. Their parents died of AIDS in 2007 leaving them alone in the family. Nakigona Angel is under the care of the elder brother Lugona James who is 18 years. This boy works hard in order to meet the needs of the young brother and sisters, but sometimes he fails to meet all of their essential needs such as clothes, kaffin, soap, salt, food, and medical expenses. Nakigona sleeps on the papyrus mats which she weaves and covers herself with a new blanket she got from school. She also sleeps under a mosquito net, she got from school.

## NALUSIBA JOAN



Na-lu-si-ba Joan is 10 years old. She is in primary two and stays at school. Nalusiba Joan stays with her mother Namugelwa Florence who is a school cook. Her husband died in 2007. The husband left her in a rented house and after his death the mother to Joan found it difficult to pay rental charges. When she came to school and narrated her story to us, we decided to employ her so that she can get money to meet rental charges and other home requirements. Currently Joan and her mother stay at school in a house which the school rents. Their lifestyle have improved especially by the chuck's acceptance to pay workers salaries. They thank God and pray for chuck and his family daily. Joan got a blanket and net.

**NAMIYINGO PATIENCE.**



Na-mi-yi-ngo Patience is 9 years old .she is in primary one. She lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometers from where the school is located.

Namiyingo Patience stays with her two sisters, their father died in July 2011 and the mother got married to another man leaving her children a lone in the house.

These children are under the care of the elder sister Nakanjako Phiona who is 11 years old. The church has been responsible to meet the needs of these children, the church is planning to have these children adopted into families of believers who can take care of them. Namiyingo Patience together with her two sisters sleep on one mattress which was given to them by the church. They cover them selves with a new blanket patience got from school. They also sleep under mosquito net.

## NAKAWULE MARIA



Nakawule Maria is 10 years old. She is in primary three. She lives in kiwenda village which is 4 kilometers from where the school is located. Nakawule Maria stays with her Aunt. Her parents went to rest in 2008. Her parents left three children, these three children stay with their Aunt. After realizing that he was HIV Positive, their father sold off every thing so the children had nothing to depend on .This is what compelled them to run to their Aunt for survival. Their aunt also lost her husband in 2009, she is poor and has five biological children, the other ones from Nakawule's family make a total of 8 children. Nakawule's Aunt works hard in people's gardens to get food which these children eat. They sleep on fiber mats and cover theme selves with a blanket they got from school but this is not enough for 8 children



## NABIRYO MARY



Na-bi-ryo Mary is 9 years old. She is in primary one. She stays in Lutungu village 300 meters from where the school is located. Nabiryo stays with her mother and two brothers. Her father went to rest in 2011. Nabiryo Mary was tested blood and found out that she is HIV Positive, but she has not begun taking septrin. Her mother is also HIV Positive. The mother to Nabiryo Maria is a drunkard, most her time is spent in the bars. Nabiryo Mary lives a hard life, one time we went to visit her and found her crying because she had spent the whole day without something to eat. Her attendance at school is irregular because most of the times, she works in other peoples gardens in order to get money for survival. In July last year she was deceived by a man that she was going to work in his garden but after reaching his home the man forced her to have sex with him.



## SSENYANGE JAMES



Sse-nya-nge James is 9 years old. He lives in Kiwenda village which is 4 kilo meters from where the school is located. James stays with his grand parents, his parents went to rest in 2008. James is HIV Positive he takes septrin every day which his grand father gets from Butiti dispensary. He always falls sick and his attendance at school is irregular. Though James often falls sick, he is clever and his performance in class is good. The grand parents to James are advanced in years, this forces James to do most of the work at home such as fetching water, fire wood and cooking. He sleeps on a wooden bed which is full of bed burls. He lays banana fiber mats on the bed and covers himself with an old blanket which his grand parents bought him.

## NABUKENYA JUSTINE



Na-bu-ke-nya Justine is 10 years old. She is in primary one. She lives in Lutungu village just 100 meters from where the school is located. Nabukenya stays with her mother and three brothers. Her father died in 2007, her mother is HIV Positive and takes ARVs daily. The father to Justine sold most of land he had after realizing that he was HIV Positive. He got a loan from the bank and died before the loan was settled. One year after his death, the bank sold the house where Justine and her mother were staying. Currently they stay in a rented room. Their mother works hard in gardens of other people to get what to feed these children. Justine sleeps on banana fiber mats and covers her self with a new blanket which she got from school. She also sleeps under a mosquito net she got from school.

**NALWEYISO FLORENCE.**



Na-lwe-yiso Florence is one year old, she is in primary one. She stays in Lutungu village 100 meters from where the school is located.

Nalweyiso stays with his mother, her father died in January 2011. The mother to Nalweyiso is currently a prostitute, after the death of her husband she became desperate and decided to sell sex with every man she comes across. The mother to Nalweyiso is a drunkard and spend most of her time in bars. Currently Nalweyiso and her sister Na-mu-ki-bi Harriet have no one to take care of them. Some times they do garden work in order to get food to eat.

Florence and Harriet sleep together on floor where they lay ragged clothes, and covers them selves with a new blanket Harriet got from school. They also sleep under mosquito net.



### ***KABIITO ISAAC***

Ka-bii-to Isaac is 5 years. He is in baby Class, he lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometres from where the school is located. Kabiito Isaac stays with his mother, his father went mad in 2010, currently the father sleeps wherever he goes, some times he sleeps on the street. Kabiito's mother has three children she looks after.

They stay in a grass thatched house with the roofing full of holes, whenever it rains, the house gets full of water and every thing in the house gets wet. The mother works hard in other people's gardens to get money she uses to buy food for the children. Kabiito Isaac sleeps on fibre mats and covers himself with a blanket he got from school, he also sleeps under mosquito net got from school.



### **SEGAWA DERIC**

Se-ga-wa Deric is 7 years. He is in baby class and lives in Kiwenda village 3 kilometers from where the school is located. Segawa Deric has both parents but their father is a drunkard. He spends most of his time in bars, as he goes back home he fights with his wife and children. This has caused Segawa and his four brothers and one sister to live a hard and miserable life. The father to Segawa sold off everything they had, currently they have a small piece of land from which they do garden work. Segawa told the child monitoring group that at times they do not eat meals for some days. Sometimes they just eat raw cassava which their neighbors give them. Segawa sleeps on old clothes laid on the floor, he covers himself with a blanket and sleeps under the mosquito net got from school.



### **NAMUGENYI RITAH**

Na-mu-ge-nyi Ritah is in Top class. She is 7 years old. She lives in kiwenda village 3 kilometres from where the school is located.

Namugenyi Ritah stays with her father, her mother passed a way in 2008. After the death of her mother, the father married another wife who mistreated Ritah and finally bewitched her. After being bewitched, Ritah became mute for the whole year, one day we asked the father to bring her to the church, we prayed for her and by God's grace Ritah began to speak again. The mother is still treating her harshly, fortunately one church member has decided to adopt her and the father has approved that decision. Ritah sleeps on an old mattress which her mother gave her before she died, she covers herself with a new blanket got from school and sleeps under mosquito net.



### **TAMALE IVAN**

Ta-ma-le Ivan is 6 years old. He is in Top class. He lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometres from where the school is located.

Tamale Ivan stays with his three brothers. The parents went to rest in 2009, the elder brother Kamate Joseph is the one who takes care of the young brothers. After realizing that ,he was HIV positive, their father sold everything he had. Before the death of their mother, she had hired a room for her children, but when she died the children failed to meet rental charges, finally the landlord chased them out of his room. The elder brother had to build a hut which is grass thatched. This house was constructed on the small piece of land which their father left un sold. Unfortunately this hut leaks whenever it rains, it gets full of water and at times the children spend the whole night seated.

These children works hard in other people's gardens to get what to eat, at times some people give them food free of charge but this is done on rare cases. Ivan sleeps with one of his brothers, they sleep on dry banana leaves and covers themselves with a blanket which Ivan got from school. They also sleep under mosquito net also got from school.





### **LUKYAMUZI JOEL**

Lu-kya-mu-zi Joel is 14 years old. He is in primary three. Joel lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometres from where the school is located.

Joel stays with his Uncle, his both parents went to rest in 2006. Joel's parents died leaving him alone in the house, after the death of his parents, one of his neighbors sold off the land claiming that the land belonged to him. He claimed that the parents died after selling to him every piece of land they had, so Joel was forced to get away from this land and the house ,since he was staying there illegally. For the first time Joel had to run to the widow who promised to take care of him but as time went on, the widow began to force him into sexual act, when Joel reported that to us, we advised him to go and stay with his Uncle. Unfortunately Joel was tested blood last year and the results indicated that he is HIV positive, currently Joel takes Septrin which he gets from Butiti dispensary. Joel is very hard working in class and capable of getting good grade at the end of primary seven. He sleeps on papyrus mats and covers himself with a blanket got from school. He also sleeps under mosquito nets.





### **NAKABAZI CISSY**

Na-ka-ba-zi Cissy is 10 years old. Nakabazi Cissy is in primary three. She lives in Lutungu village 1 kilometer from where the school is located. Cissy is the elder sister of the three children.

Their father died in March 2012, after the death of their father, their mother got married to another man leaving children alone in the house. These children live a very hard life as they try to meet every basic need at home by themselves. Cissy's attendance is irregular because at times she misses the school and goes to work in other people's gardens in order to get money she uses to buy food which they eat at home. Her brother and sister do not go to any school, we plan to enroll them in our school next year so that they can also acquire education and be nurtured spiritually as we pray for them and ask God's will to be done in their lives. Cissy and her sister sleep on the floor where they lay old clothes, they cover themselves with a blanket which cissy got from school. They also sleep under mosquito net got from school.

Their brother sleeps on dry banana leaves, he covers himself with a bark cloth.



### **MATOVU GEOFREY**

Ma-to-vu is 9 years old. He is in primary two. He lives in Lutungu village 200 metres from where the school is located. Matovu Geoffrey is a double orphan, his parents went to rest in 2007 leaving behind two children, unfortunately the brother to matovu Geoffrey suffered from malaria for almost a week and finally passed away. Currently Geoffrey is also infected with HIV yet he is exposed to hard work. Their family is very poor, they do not have land at all, whatever food they eat is bought using the money they get from people who give them some work to do in their gardens. During the time when he is not at school, Geoffrey wears clothes which are full of holes, he told the child-monitoring team that at times, he spends the whole day without any food to eat especially when his aunt falls sick and does not go to work for money which she uses to buy food. The husband to her aunt is totally desparate, he doesn't take care of his family, because he knows that any time he will pass away.

Geoffrey sleeps on the fibre mats, he covers himself with a blanket and sleeps under mosquito nets both got from the school.



### **NAMASIKO RASHID**

Na-ma-si-ko Rashida is 9 years old. She is in Baby class. Rashida lives in Kiwenda village 4 kilometres from where the school is located Rashida stays with his father and step mother, his mother separated with his father due to rampant domestic violences in their homes.

The father to Rashida is a drunkard, he spends most of his time in bars and spends much of his money with prostitutes. The step mother to Rashida mistreats her, she makes her to overwork. One day she bought poison to commit suicide but her fellow child realized that and reported to their neighbors, lucky enough their neighbors took away poison from Rashida before she committed suicide. After realizing that we decided to enroll her into our school, so that she can be educated and nurtured spiritually.

We also went to their family to collect data about this child, we told the father to be responsible and meet simple needs for this child, we requested the step mother to stop mistreating the child since this was the reason why she wanted to commit suicide, the church is responsible for buying books, pencils and other scholastic materials for Rashida.

Rashida sleeps on a papyrus mat and covers herself with a blanket she got from school. She also sleeps under mosquito net also got from school.



### **TUMUKUNDE PETER**

Tu-mu-kun-de Peter is 13 years old. He is in primary two. Tumukunde Peter lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometer from where the school is located. Tumukunde peter stays with his 5 brothers and 2 sisters, their father went to rest in 2007 leaving them with their mother, unfortunately their mother also passed away in June 2011. Currently they are under the care of their elder brother Twine Jude who works had together with his brothers to ensure that they get food to eat. Tumukunde is a hard working boy in class, he pays much attention in class and his performance is very good.

Tumukund Peter sleeps under mosquito net, he covers hi mself with a blanket which he got from school.

## **NANTONGO PHIONA**



Na-nto-ngo Phiona is 5 years old. Phiona is in Baby class. She lives in Lutungu village which is 2 kilometres from where the school is located. Nantongo Phiona stays with her Aunt, her father died in May 2009 leaving behind three children who were staying with their mother, unfortunately their mother also died in December 2011. Their father died after selling off the land he had including the small house where they were staying. This forced the mother to Phiona to rent a room, where she had to stay with her children. She had to work hard in other people's gardens to get money which she was using to pay rent and buy food for her children. After her death, the children had to join the family of their Aunt whose husband is a drunkard. He doesn't take care of his family.

He spends most of his time in bars taking alcohol.

The Aunt to Phiona loves them and works hard to ensure that they get food which they eat at home.

Nantongo Phiona, together with her two sisters sleep on an old mattress, they cover themselves with the blanket which Phiona got from school, they also sleep under mosquito net got from school.

## **NAMULEMA RESTY**



Na-mu-le-ma Resty is 6 years old. She is in Top class. She stays in Lutungu village I kilometer from where the school is located. Resty has both parents, her father has three wives.

After the father to Resty married the third wife, the mother to Resty decided to separate with the husband but the chairperson LC.I advised her to stay in her family as she looks after her children. However, she decided not to engage herself in sexual act with the husband to avoid getting infected with HIV, this forced the husband not to take care of this family any more.

The mother to Resty works hard in other people's gardens to get money which she uses to buy food and other essential needs for the children.

Namulema Resty sleeps on papyrus mats. She covers herself with a blanket which she got from school. She also sleeps under mosquito net. Before she got the mosquito net, she used to suffer from malaria fever but ever since she got a mosquito net, no more cases of malaria have been observed so far.



## **NAKAWOJWA PRAXEDER**



Na-ka-wo-jwa Praxeder is 10 years old. Praxeder is in primary two. She stays in Katonto village which is 4 kilometres from where the school is located. Nakawojwa Praxeder stays with her grand father; her parents went to heaven in 2008, leaving behind 5 children. Their elder brother had to take care of them after the death of their parents. When their grand mother passed away, Praxeder was taken to her grandfather's family to take care of him.

Nakawojwa Praxeder takes care of her grand father who is advanced in years. Some times she does not appear at school due to many activities she has to do at home. Praxeder sleeps on an old mattress which her grand father gave her. She covers herself with a blanket got from school. Praxeder also sleeps under mosquito net which she got from school.

## **NAMATOVU ROSE**



Na-ma-to-vu Rose is 7 years old. She is in top class. Rose lives in Kiwenda village three kilometers from where the school is located.

Namatovu Rose stays with her parents who are very poor.

They live in a small hut which leaks when it rains. The father to Rose spends most of his time in bars. He doesn't take care of his family. The mother works in other people's gardens to get food which they eat at home. Rose told us that at times they for go meals for the whole day.

Namatovu sleeps on fiber mats and covers herself with a blanket which she got from school. She sleeps under mosquito net also got from school.



## **NAKAAYI PRISCA**



Na-kaa-yi Prisca is 7 years old. She is in top class. Prisca lives in Kiwenda village 2 kilometres from where the school is located. Nakaayi Prisca stays with her grand parents. Her father died in 2011. After the death of her both parents, prisca went to stay with her grand parents. She was tested blood and the results indicated that Prisca is HIV positive, she takes septrin which she gets from Butiti dispensary. The grand parents to Prisca are very old, so Prisca is the one who is responsible to do most of the domestic work at home. Nakaayi Prisca sleeps on papyrus mats and covers herself with a blanket which she got from school. She used to suffer from malaria fever but after getting the mosquito net the malaria cases are no longer reported. Prisca is very active in class and capable of getting good results.

## **NAMBEJJA MARION**



Na-mbe-jja Marion is 7 years old. She is in Top class. Nambejja Marion lives in Lutugu village 200 metres from where the school is located. Marion stays with her two brothers and their mother. Their father went to work in Pader district in 2001 and up to now he is still there. Some people say that he married another wife and that there is no hope for him to come back home.

Their mother cultivates the small land the husband left with her to get food for children, but the food got from this land is not enough because the land is very small. Some times she works in other people's gardens to get money which she uses to buy essential needs at home such as soap, paraffin, salt and clothes for children.

Nambejja Marion sleeps on old ragged clothes; she covers herself with a blanket got from school. She also sleeps under the mosquito net

## **NALUGAZI PAULINE**



Na-lu-ga-nzi Pauline is 5 years old. She is in Baby class. Pauline lives in Lutungu village 2 kilometres from where the school is located. Naluganzi Pauline lost her both parents, she stays with her three brothers. Their elder brother Kagayi, John takes care of them, Kagayi John works hard to meet the needs of his two brothers and one sister but at times he fails since he is the only person responsible to meet all the essential needs at home. One day we went to visit them and found out that the hut in which they were staying was leaking, so we had to help them by constructing for them a small house of 8 Iron sheets. ## **JJUKO EMMANUEL**



Jju-ko Emmanuel is 8 years old. He is in Primary one. Emmanuel lives in Butiti village 4 kilometers from where the school is located.

Jjuko Emmanuel stays with his mother and two brothers ,the father to jjuko married the second wife and decided to neglect the mother to Jjuko Emmanuel. He no longer takes care of this family, he even chased her a way from his house. The mother to Jjuko hired a room where she stays with her children. She works hard in her small piece of land to get food for her children.

Most of the time, she works in other people's gardens in order to get money which she uses to meet domestic needs.

Jjuko Emmanuel sleeps with his two brothers on fiber mats and covers themselves with a blanket which Jjuko got from school. They also sleep under a mosquito net got from school.

## **SENKUGU ANDREW**



Sse-nku-ngu Andrew is in Top class. She is 7 years old, Andrew lives in Kiwenda village 3 kilometers from where the school is located. Andrew stays with his grand mother, his father died in 2010 and the mother left him alone in the family, the neighbors to Andrew had to take him to his grand father who takes care of him. Andrew was born with HIV, he often falls sick but the grand mother tries hard to make sure that the child regains his health by taking him to hospitals which are well facilitated. They have advised the grandmother to start giving Septrin to the child every day. Ssenkungu Andrew sleeps on a good mattress, he has good bed sheets. He covers himself with a blanket which he got from school. He also sleeps under mosquito net got from school.



## **SENYONDO RICHARD**



Sse-nyo-ndo Richard is 9 years old. He has been in primary one at Good Hope Kalisizo. Ssenyondo Richard is lame, he does not move at all, instead he crawls. His mother has brought him to school today and told us that Richard has been studying at Good Hope Kalisizo under the care of his elder brother who have been a teacher at that very school. Sadly the brother to Richard died in a car accident on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2012, so they decided to bring him to our school. The mother to Richard wanted him to stay at school but we have told him that at the moment we do not have rooms where children can sleep. We have advised the mother to get any family that is near to school where this child can reside as he goes to school daily.

The mother has accepted the advice and she is trying to find a family that can be willing to stay with Richard as he goes to our school.

The most challenge we have observed with Richard's movement is during rainy season when all places are muddy, he finds much difficult to make his movement.

It would be much relieving if he could get a wheel chair which we think will solve the problem of his difficulty in movement this will enable him to complete his studies.

**N.B** Richard has not been among the children we have at school, the mother brought him last Monday.
